Welcome to La Paloma Academy's 2015 Title I Summer School and Kinder Camp! We are so excited to have your child come and be a part of our free program to help prepare him/her for the upcoming school year. We developed this four-week session, which will take place from June 1st to June 26th, in order to address the academic needs of students who are currently receiving Title I support or have been recommended by their classroom teacher.

High quality instruction will be provided daily in the areas of reading, writing, and math. Of these core subjects, we will be specifically working on the key standards that students need mastery of in order to be ready for their new grade level. A team of highly qualified teachers has been selected to serve on our summer school staff. In addition to remedial work in the core subjects, students will have the opportunity to grow accustomed to the procedures and expectations of the grade level they are entering. Many students will be working with the teacher whose class they will be assigned to in the upcoming school year.

Summer school hours will be Monday through Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Please send your child with a snack and water bottle daily. We truly want to provide the best possible education for your child at La Paloma Academy and look forward to seeing you soon! Policies and Procedures for Title I Summer School and Kinder Camp

Dress Policy

Free dress will be permitted during summer school, as long as attire is appropriate. Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than two inches above the knee, sleeveless tops must be 2 inches wide across the shoulder with no straps showing, and no inappropriate images can be displayed on t-shirts or other clothing items.

Homework

There will be no homework assigned during this four-week program. All work will be completed during the school day. However, there will be some at-home activities provided that will help your child review what they are learning in summer school, so please check your child's folder daily for these.

Supplies

Pencils or pens, a pocket folder, and a spiral notebook are the only required materials for incoming 1st–8th grade students, (**Kinder Camp** students do not need any supplies). If you are in need of any of these supplies, let your child s teacher or the program director know, and we will provide the necessary items. You may pack a snack and water bottle for your child, as we will have a short snack break daily.

No-show/Unexcused Absence Policy

Students who do not show up on the first day of summer school will be automatically disenrolled from the program. We have a waiting list of students and want to ensure that all participants who are committed to being in the program are given the opportunity. Likewise, students who have two unexcused absences will be dismissed from the program. After the first day, Kinder Camp students will be dismissed from the program after one unexcused absence, as their sessions are only four days long.

Excused Absence Policy

If you know your child will need to miss a day of summer school, please notify the teacher or director immediately. However, please note that three excused absences will result in dismissal from the program. We have a waiting list of students who are eager to be invited to attend the program, so it is imperative that students be fully invested in the program.

Tardy Policy

Summer school will begin promptly at 8:00 a.m. It is crucial that all students arrive on time each day, and prepared to learn. We have limited time to review important skills that students require for their success in the upcoming school year. Interruptions in instruction due to tardiness have a negative impact on the classroom environment and create setbacks for other students who are trying to learn. Three tardies, either excused or unexcused, will be equivalent to one absence during summer school.

Three Strikes Behavior Policy

We will take disruptive behavior very seriously in summer school. Any student who disrupts the class or behaves in a manner that is not aligned with La Paloma Academy's school-wide rules will be sent to the office, the parent will be contacted, and the student may be sent home for the day.
