Welcome to La Paloma Academy's 2016 Title I Summer School and Kinder Camp! We are so excited to have your child participate in our free program to help prepare him/her for the upcoming school year. We developed this four-week session, which will take place June 6–June 30, in order to address the academic needs of students who are currently receiving Title I support or have been recommended by their classroom teacher.

High-quality instruction will be provided daily in the areas of reading, writing, and math. A team of highly qualified teachers has been selected to serve on our summer school staff. In addition to remedial work in the core subjects, students will have the opportunity to grow accustomed to the procedures and expectations of the grade level they will be entering in the fall. Many students will be working with the teacher whose class they will be assigned to in the upcoming school year.

Summer school and Kinder Camp hours will be Monday–Thursday, 8–11:30 a.m. Please send your child with a snack and water bottle daily. Policies and Procedures for Title I Summer School and Kinder Camp

Dress Policy

Free dress will be permitted during summer school, as long as attire is appropriate. Shorts and skirts must be no shorter than two inches above the knee, sleeveless tops must be 2 inches wide across the shoulder with no straps showing, and no inappropriate images can be displayed on T-shirts or other clothing items. Shoes need to be closed-toe, please no sandals.

Supplies

Pencils or pens, a pocket folder, and a spiral notebook are the only required materials for incoming 1st-8th grade students (Kinder Camp students do not need any supplies). If you are in need of any of these supplies, please email the Program Coordinator. Please send a **water bottle and snack** with your child every day.

No-show/Absence Policy

Students who do not show up on the first day of summer school will be automatically disenrolled from the program. Likewise, students who have two unexcused absences will be dismissed from the program. If your child will be absent, please notify the Program Coordinator immediately. However, please note three excused absences will result in dismissal from the program.

Excused Absence Policy

If you know your child will need to miss a day of summer school, please notify the teacher or director immediately. However, please note that three excused absences will result in dismissal from the program. We have a waiting list of students who are eager to be invited to attend the program, so it is imperative that students be fully invested in the program.

Tardy Policy

Summer school will begin promptly at 8 a.m. It is crucial for all students to arrive on time each day. Please make sure your child is prepared to learn. Three tardies, either excused or unexcused, will be equivalent to one absence during summer school.

Late Policy

If your child is not registered for the half-day La Paloma Summer Camp following Summer School/Kinder Camp, you MUST pick him/her up promptly at 11:30 a.m. Parents who pick up their children after 11:40 a.m. will be charged a fee of \$1.00/minute for every minute they are late.

Three Strikes Policy

Children with poor behavior and/or late parent pickup, will receive a Strike. Students who receive a total of three Strikes will be removed from the program, and readmittance will only be considered following a meeting with parent(s)/guardian(s), teacher, and Program Director.
