PLEASE VOLUNTEER

The commitment of our parents is key to La Paloma's success and we are always looking for volunteers. The initial processing takes 24 hours, but the remainder can take several weeks. Once the application is processed visitors are welcome, but must register at the office.

With the start of a new school year, your fingerprints from last year may have expired. Call the front office to schedule an appointment to have your fingerprints renewed for this year.

UNIFORMS ON SALE

We have both La Paloma Academy collared shirts (\$12) and T-shirts (\$10) on sale. Your child can wear the T-shirt every Friday with jeans. We also have zippered sweatshirts (\$20) and pullovers (\$15) order yours NOW!

ATTENTION PARENTS

Make sure your child gets to school on time. The last school bell rings at 8:30 a.m. and breakfast will be served in the classroom at this time. If your child is tardy, he or she will not be served breakfast in the morning.

DRESS CODE REMINDER

We require students to adhere to our uniformed dress code. Solid-color polo shirts in the school colors: red (not maroon), white, or navy blue can be worn, or La Paloma polo shirts available in the office for \$12 each. Slacks, shorts, jumpers, capri pants, and skirts in khaki or navy blue are acceptable (no other "bottom" colors are permitted). Uniforms should not be either excessively baggy or too tight. The dress code applies to all students at all times during the school day, including after-school, and schoolsponsored events and activities.
