# PLEASE VOLUNTEER

# **ATTENDANCE POLICIES**

La Paloma Academy is committed to:

- Working with students and their families to ensure that all students attend school regularly
- Understanding there are a variety of factors that may influence school attendance
- Providing strength-based and culturally appropriate interventions and services, including parent education and referrals to school/communitybased resources
- Addressing excessive absenteeism, chronic tardies, and early departures as quickly as possible
- Communicating the issue to the parents/guardians
- Partnering with parents/guardians and students to develop strategies to address the absenteeism and produce a change in behavior

#### **PARKING LOT EXPECTATIONS**

Parents, please help keep our parking lot safe!

- **YELLOW CURB:** This is a quick Drop-Off/Pick-Up zone. Please remain in your vehicle. No parking. Do not exit your car.
- **RED CURB:** This is a Fire Lane. No stopping. No parking. FOR YOUR CHILD'S SAFETY - DO NOT DROP OFF OR PICK UP IN THIS LANE! Always pull your car as close to the yellow curb as possible to drop off or pick up your child.
- AFTER SCHOOL: Students who are getting picked up can wait in front of the school from 3:15–3:30 p.m. (K–6), 3:30–3:45 p.m. (7/8). Students must report to the After-School Program by 3:30 p.m. (K–6) or 3:45 p.m. (7/8). If you are waiting and don't see your child in front of the school, please park your car in the parking lot and go to the office to have them paged from the After-School Program.

For your child's safety, make sure they wait right in front of the school and wait until you pull up. Students who wander out to the parking lot or dirt lot are not safe. Please reinforce this with your student.

• **INSIDER TIP:** 3:15–3:25 p.m. is the busiest time in the parking lot. Try to arrive after 3:25 p.m. to avoid the traffic.
