



Reopening 2020 District Policies

**Site Based Policies available at each school and provide more detail as applicable to the individual school site.

Health and Safety Protocols

Visual and/or temperature checks performed daily on staff and students. Non-touch thermometers have been purchased for all health clerks, teachers, front desk staff, and bus drivers.

All students and staff when entering classrooms and cafeteria are required to wash and/or disinfect their hands.

All staff and students over the age of 5 years must wear face coverings such as masks and/or shields. Students will be allowed to remove masks when they are in a safe area and able to socially distance (for example, when working at a desk within a safe distance from another student), under teacher/staff supervision. Students will be allowed to remove masks when playing outside and able to socially distance, under teacher/staff supervision. Students will be trained on proper use of facemasks, social distancing, and when/how to use them and clean them.

All AC Units have been serviced to increase maximum airflow into the classrooms.

Posting of signs are displayed throughout the school, explaining guidelines, hygiene and best practices.

Limiting parents, volunteers and visitors on campus is recommended for the safety of students and staff.

Physical Distancing

Classrooms have been equipped with desks, all in rows, forward facing and spread apart are far as possible. If tables are used, students will sit on one side, spread apart. Teachers have removed non-essential items to help with disinfecting rooms at the end of the day.

Lunchtime eating areas have been expanded and additional outside/inside tables have been purchased as needed.



Students will be trained on physical interactions such as standing in line (arms length), and moving around campus and halls to help maintain safe distancing as much as possible.

Classroom Procedures

Students and staff will clean hands upon entering the classroom.

Students and staff will clean desks, tables, chairs, and learning materials when leaving the classroom. Industrial size wipe dispensers and disinfecting wipes have been purchased for all classrooms.

Non-essential items/manipulatives will be removed from the classroom. For any manipulatives used, the teacher will disinfect them at the end of the day.

Limit the amount of shared materials within the classroom.

Sick Policy

Students or teachers showing signs of sickness or not feeling well will be sent home. Parents are responsible for keeping their kids home if they are sick.

Students or teachers who believe they have or have had COVID-19 and had symptoms may return to school AFTER no fever (following school fever policy) and no symptoms. (Follow CDC Guidelines)

If you have had exposure to someone with COVID-19, you should closely monitor symptoms and follow CDC guidelines. Please **stay home** if you are experiencing any symptoms.

Students or teachers who have been confirmed with COVID will follow those orders as provided by their Physician. (Follow CDC Guidelines)

Facility and Quarantine Procedures

If a student or employee is reported/diagnosed/confirmed with COVID-19, the classroom and/or school will be immediately sanitized and disinfected. Electrostatic machines have been purchased for all schools. All students/staff of that class and any others having had direct close contact will be immediately contacted. Schools will work with health officials, and follow recommended procedures.
